Republican Presidential Candidate Ron Paul will visit Cal State Fullerton on his second anticipated California Universities Tour

Westminster, CA Following the success of his previous visits to Cal State Chino, UCLA, and UC Berkeley in early April, Republican Presidential candidate Ron Paul will make another California University Tour starting on May 2 with mass rallies at Cal State University Fullerton on Wednesday, continuing to UC Davis on Thursday, and concluding at UC San Diego on Friday. All events are scheduled to start at 7pm PST. Each of Ron Paul's previous California rallies have attracted crowds averaging 5,000 people or more.

Last week, Paul concluded his successful Texas Universities tour with thousands coming to his rallies at UT El Paso, UT Austin, and University of Houston. With news media reporting that Ron Paul has recently won state delegations from Iowa, Minnesota, Washington and Louisiana, his growing momentum going into the Texas Republican primary will continue to attract larger crowds wherever he speaks.

Ron Paul, a OB/GYN doctor by training, is a 12-term Republican US Congressman from Texas and expert in monetary policy serving currently as Chairman of the Congressional Subcommittee on Domestic Monetary Policy and Technology; Dr. Paul has been credited for predicting the subprime housing crisis in 2007. He is known among both his colleagues in Congress and his constituents for his consistent voting record in the House of Representatives: Dr. Paul never votes for legislation unless the proposed measure is expressly authorized by the Constitution. In the words of former Treasury Secretary William Simon, Dr. Paul is the "one exception to the Gang of 535" on Capitol Hill.
